Hawaii's Bob Wagner

On the Rainbows 3rd 60 point game of the year:

"That's not just the offense, that's great defense and great special teams. That's how you win games by those scores, when you play great in all three phases. And we played really well in three phases (tonight.) If anything, we probably did better on defense and on special teams than on offense, though we certainly did play well offensively.

It was a real solid team effort. Certainly when you play real good defense it keeps you in every game. The first half, we got some ~~max~~ points on the board, we stalled a little bit but we really won the kicking game really big. We blocked a punt, we had a couple of good punt returns. And the offense did well enough. In the second half we just kept the pressure on. Looking ahead:
