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POST GAME QUOTES AND NOTES

BYU HEAD COACH LAVELL EDWARDS:

"We've been coming over here a lot of years, and when we finally let one out, we do it up right--Just like Utah last year. Hawaii came out and did a great job. They executed flawlessly. They've played probably as good as I've ever seen them play over here. Tonight, they were the better team, they deserved to win. It doesn't make a difference (the loss) as far as the conference is concerned because if we can win the rest of our games, we will be the champion. We never stopped them (Hawaii) all night long; we hurt ourselves with execution at times. I don't think there is any one thing that made a difference. They've been a good defensive team all year long."

HAWAII HEAD COACH BOB WAGNER:

"We're not that good, and they're not that bad, but we can be a good football team when we play well...IT is certainly a great win. It hasn't sunk in yet, but the way we did it and the score was fantastic...It's a great win for the program. There is no justice in college football. If we don't win another game or two and don't go to a bowl game. Being 6-2 and with a win over an excellent football team then there is no justice in college football...I have tremendous respect for BYU. We've been close so many times and come up short; it's taken a lot out of me over the years. It's just a great win."

GARRETT GABRIEL:

"We had a good game plan. We knew we were quicker than BYU, but they were bigger. Coach Johnson told us that if we executed, good things would happen... I'm the ~~happiest~~ happiest football player on the earth...I never thought I would be sitting on the bench in the fourth quarter, enjoying that kind of lead."

MARK ODOM:

"If we play hard, and play smart, and not make mistakes, we can beat almost anybody."

Detmer is a good passer, so we knew we had to upset his rythm. Luckily, we were able too and we came up on top."
