Dave Kragthorpe, OSU Head Coach

"All I know is that we had a chance to win the game with the ball on the one yard line with four cracks to get it in. This would have put us up by 5 points and would have made it very hard for Hawaii to come back. I can't comment on the fumble as I have not had a chance to see it on film. I have been told by ~~people~~ people in the press box that he did score (Pat Chaffey), but as I said, I can't comment on something that I have not seen on film.

It was the worst possible thing that could have happen to us, fumbling on the one yard line. I feel sorry for Pat Chaffey as he has been a great football player for us at Oregon State and I think it is unfortunate that he could be made the goat in some peoples eyes. However, we missed two very makeable field goals as well and that hurt also.

I thought we played extremely hard tonight. We have played two very hard games back to back gainst Oregon and Hawaii and I am extremely proud of our football team for doing that.

Hawaii is very difficult to run against but we felt we had to make an effort to keep them honest. Nick Schichtle played well overall tonight. He made some mistakes but he is our best passer for getting the ball down the field. Schichtle and Hubbard (Reggie) finished their careers with big games ~~xxx~~ tonight. We played this game for our seniors.

I thought our pass protection improved in the second half and it helped our offense.

In a lot of ways, this game was a capsule of our season as this game was very frustrating. It was one of the most difficult defeats I have been involved in.
