

Hawaii Head Coach Bob Wagner: "We're very disappointed for our fans that we didn't make a better game of it...We just got down early so much. But give Texas a lot of credit. They're very skilled and very experienced. They got a lot of people back from a good team a year ago. They added a lot of speed and it really showed.

I thought our guys played hard and fought pretty good despite what was going on... We need to throw a little more effectively. The major problem is we didn't make any big plays, and they certainly did. If you're giving up big plays to someone, you need to get some back.

(On Glenn Freitas, Hawaii starting quarterback): "Glenn's got a severely bruised right shoulder. I have no idea how long he'll be out. He did some things well when he was in there.

Texas Head Coach John Mackovic: "First of all, I was very please with the solid performance that we gave, especially early in the game. We played a lot of young players in the second half that worked to our advantage to be able to do that. We had a commanding lead. Rainbow Warriors are to be congratulated too for the way they played. They could've given up, the quarterback went out, some other players went out and I think they have an offense that will scare some people and put points on the board. Bob Wagner and I are good friends and I hate to coach against people I have a good friendship with, but you've got to do that. I hope to have a good season, maybe this will be a good thing for them to get back into the game. We did a lot of little things we shouldn't have done. We got a lot of work to do, we need to get back to class, get into the swing of the semester, those are important days next week for us to do it. Those plays with the running backs, those young guys, they ran the wrong way sometimes, had us pulling our hair out on a couple of situations But when they had the ball, and they hit the crease, they showed why we've been impressed and why we've been excited ab out their performance and what they've been able to bring to the team.
