Hawai'i Head Coach Bob Wagner: "It was certainly a tough day for us, but a great day for Wyoming. I thought they played a lot better than they did a week ago against Air Force and we give them all the credit. We had a concern early because they got the running game going better than we thought they would. One of our highlights was our freshman punter Chad Shrout who did an outstanding job for us. George Ornellas was hurt most of the week and played a limited role today. We had some great downs today, but we have not been a big play offense for over a year now. It was frustrating for our players because they continued to try. Not much of what we called on defense worked very well. Offensively, give them (Wyoming) credit. They kick the ball off very well and we always had a long way to go. We just couldn't put the ball in the endzone today. Sometimes, what it comes down to is playing great defense and if you don't do that then you have to match point for point. We just have to take a look at what happened and sometimes it's not as bad as it appears but we just have to go out and prove it. I'm disappointed that we didn't play very well. (On travel): We would have liked to get in earlier but you can't really adjust to the time change, but we can't use that as an excuse. That's just life in the WAC.

From Wyoming Head Coach Joe Tiller:

"Needless to say that was refreshing to play that way after the way we struggled last week. Number one we played real well on both sides of the ball. Number two Hawaii was out of sync. I 'm not sure we are that good, and I'm not sure they are that bad.

"Made some plays. We rushed the ball well early, and that helped us. We were balanced today, and that's what every program is after. I guess we were just about as balanced as a team can get.

"I think we were all a bit surprised that Wallwork rushed as well as he did. He does have good mobility, and he showed that. Certainly his improvement today was a big boost to our team.

"I thought the defense played well, but it played well last week too. The difference is that we did not make the turnovers today as we did last week. Also, we stayed "up" on the game. We did not let down even though we had that big halftime lead.

"This team practiced very hard this week, and I think that helped them. This is the type of team that must work hard during the week .

"We also had the opportunity to play some young guys. Not only does that help those individuals, but it helps the team, depth wise and morale wise. This win helps obviously.

Injury report for Wyoming: Tight end Greg Kuhn injured his left knee, and will be evaluated first of the week.
