M NEWS AND NOTES

- Hawai'i is 7-2 in the all-time series versus San Diego.
- The last time Hawai'i faced San Diego was during the 2010 season when the 'Bows went 3-0 versus the Toreros. Hawai'i won the regular season meeting in San Diego, then beat the Toreros twice at the NCAA Tempe Regional hosted by Arizona State. UH had three future major league players on that 2010 roster Kolten Wong, Greg Garcia and David Freitas.
- Last time out, Hawai'i took two out of three from Big West perennial power Cal State Fullerton at Les Murakami Stadium. After dropping the series opener, UH bounced back by winning the final two games to win the series.
- In the series victory over Cal State Fullerton, junior Logan Pouelsen stole the show in the three-game set. The Huntington Beach native had a pinch-hit RBI single in the opener then followed with a walk-off three-run home run to win game two. In the series finale, Pouelsen started on the mound and went 5.0 inning, allowing just one run on four hits.
- There are 11 players on Hawai'i's current roster from the state of California.
- $\bullet\,$ The 'Bows have gone 10-14 in non-conference games this season.
- Now in his 18th season as the UH Skipper, Mike Trapasso is three wins away 500 for his career.
- Following the single game at San Diego, Hawai'i will head to Northridge, Calif. for a three-game Big West matchup with CSUN April 26-28.

- Redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas is 41st in the nation with a 0.94 WHIP.

HITTING NOTES

- UH has not been outscored in a series since a four-game set vs. Cal State Bakersfield (March 14-17).
- On the season, Hawai'i has only been outscored in three of its 10 series.
- UH is 14-2 when scoring six or more runs this season. When scoring five or fewer runs, the 'Bows are 2-18.
- The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 57-32 in the eighth and ninth innings. The 'Bows have won six games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.
- Freshman Scotty Scott has hit in the leadoff spot in all 36 games this season. He's the only player to hit in the same spot in the lineup in every game this year.
