In the series finale, Pouelsen started on the mound and went 5.0 inning, allowing just one run on four hits.

- Hawaii went 1-2 versus CSUN last season at Les Murakami Stadium.
- The Rainbow Warriors are 19-32 in the all-time series versus the Matadors.

ON A ROLL

- Brennen Hancock's 13 game hitting streak came to an end during the Cal State Fullerton series, but the junior still has a 18 game streak of reaching base safely entering the CSUN series.
- During the Cal State Fullerton series, Scotty Scott had his 21-game streak of reaching base safely come to a close.

DT

- Redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas is second among active D1 pitchers with 26 career saves.
- The 2019 NCBWA Preseason Second Team All-American is also fifth among active D1 pitchers with a career ERA of 1.99 (MIN - IP: 75.0; ERA: 0.10).
- In his last six appearances, Thomas has allowed just one run in 14.2 innings.

CHASING 500

- Head Coach Mike Trapasso is in his 18th season as the UH skipper.
- He currently has 498 career wins (all at UH).
- He is second in program history for career wins behind Les Murakami (1,079 wins).

PITCHING / DEFENSE NOTES

- Hawaii is 67th nationally with a .974 fielding percentage.
- UH has utilized eight different starting pitchers this season.
- Out of the bullpen, three different pitchers have earned saves this season (Dylan Thomas, Calvin Turchin, Cade Smith).
- Since head coach Mike Trapasso moved Dylan Thomas back to the bullpen in late March, Dylan Thomas has gone 14.2 innings over six appearances, allowing just one run.
- Hawaii pitchers are tied for second in the Big West with 7 runners picked off. Aaron Davenport has picked off three runners.
- UH catchers Tyler Murray is fourth in the Big West in runners caught stealing with eight. Dallas Duarte is sixth with six.
- UH pitchers are fifth in the Big West in ERA (4.50) and fourth in opponents batting average (.266).
- Hawaii's staff is fourth in the BW in batters struck out (270).
- Redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas is 41st in the nation with a 0.94 WHIP.

HITTING NOTES

- UH has not been outscored in a series since a four-game set vs. Cal State Bakersfield (March 14-17).
- On the season, Hawaii has only been outscored in three of its 10 series.
- UH is 14-2 when scoring six or more runs this season. When scoring five or fewer runs, the 'Bows are 3-18.
- The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 59-33 in the eighth and ninth innings. The 'Bows have won six games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.
- Freshman Scotty Scott has hit in the leadoff spot in all 37 games this season. He's the only player to hit in the same spot in the lineup in every game this year.
- Hawaii ranks third in the Big West with a .278 batting average.
- Three UH hitters rank in the top 64 nationally in toughest to strike out. Dallas Duarte (13th - 8 Ks / 114 AB), Maaki Yamazaki (38th - 13 Ks / 147 AB), Daylen Calicdan (99th - 14 Ks / 120 AB).
