## **ABOUT THE MATCHUP**

- Hawai'i and Cal Baptist have never faced each other.
- Cal Baptist is the second first-time opponent for UH this season (Longwood).

#### DT

- Redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas is second among active D1 pitchers with 26 career saves.
- The 2019 NCBWA Preseason Second Team All-American is also fifth among active D1 pitchers with a career ERA of 1.94 (MIN IP: 75.0; ERA: 0.10).
- In his last seven appearances, Thomas has allowed just one run in 17.1 innings.

#### **CHASING 500**

- Head Coach Mike Trapasso is in his 18th season as the UH skipper.
- He currently has 499 career wins (all at UH).
- He is second in program history for career wins behind Les Murakami (1,079 wins).

#### **PITCHING / DEFENSE NOTES**

- Hawai'i is 78th nationally with a .973 fielding percentage.
- UH has utilized eight different starting pitchers this season.
- Out of the bullpen, three different pitchers have earned saves this season (Dylan Thomas, Calvin Turchin, Cade Smith).
- Since head coach Mike Trapasso moved Dylan Thomas back to the bullpen in late March, Dylan Thomas has gone 17.1 innings over seven appearances, allowing just one run.
- Hawai'i pitchers are tied for third in the Big West with 7 runners picked off. Aaron Davenport has picked off three runners.
- UH catchers Tyler Murray is tied for fourth in the Big West in runners caught stealing with nine. Dallas Duarte is tied for seventh with six.
- UH pitchers are fifth in the Big West in ERA (4.56) and fourth in opponents batting average (.267).
- Hawai'i's staff is fourth in the BW in batters struck out (270).
- Redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas is 42nd in the nation with a 0.97 WHIP.

#### **HITTING NOTES**

- On the season, Hawai'i has only been outscored in four of its 11 series.
- UH is 14-2 when scoring six or more runs this season. When scoring five or fewer runs, the 'Bows are 4-20.
- The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 61-33 in the eighth and ninth innings. The 'Bows have won six games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.
- Freshman Scotty Scott has hit in the leadoff spot in all 40 games this season. He's the only player to hit in the same spot in the lineup in every game this year. He's also the only player to start every game.
- Hawai'i ranks third in the Big West with a .280 batting average.
- Three UH hitters rank in the top 64 nationally in toughest to strike out. Dallas Duarte (19th 9 Ks / 124 AB), Maaki Yamazaki (34th 13 Ks / 157 AB), Daylen Calicdan (139th 15 Ks / 132 AB).
- Daylen Calicdan is hitting .400 in Big West games, good for seventh in the conference. In Big West games, he's tied for first in runs scored (14) and second in hits (24).
- As a team, Hawai'i has faced 12 different opponents for a series or single game in 2019. The Bows have hit .300 or better versus six of them.
- In four of the five series versus Big West opponents on the year, Hawai'i hit .305 or better as a team.


