NEWS AND NOTES

- Hawai'i returns to Les Murakami Stadium to face first-place UC Santa Barbara.
- It will be the first action for the Rainbow Warriors since a 4-1 win at Cal Poly on May 5 to cap an eight-game road trip.
- The last time UH played at home was April 20 when the 'Bows earned a 3-1 win over Cal State Fullerton. Hawai'i is 14-15 at home this season.
- Last season, UH went 1-2 against the Gauchos to close the season in Santa Barbara. UCSB won the first two games before Adam Fogel's three-run home run helped lift the Rainbow Warriors to a 10-6 win in the season finale.
- Hawai'i is 19-16 in the all-time series versus UC Santa Barbara. The last time the Gauchos came to Honolulu was 2017 when the 'Bows won two out of three.
- Following Sunday's game, UH will hold its annual Senior Day presentation to honor Colin Ashworth, Dominic DeMiero, Kash Koltermann, Ethan Lopez and Maaki Yamazaki.
- With 27 career saves, Dylan Thomas is currently tied for second in program history with Lenny Linsky. One more save would put him in a tie with Gene Smith for the most career saves in UH history (28). Among active D-1 pitchers, the redshirt junior is tied for second with 27 saves and is third with a career ERA of 1.88.
- The Gauchos are ranked in the national polls, as high as number six in the May 13th Collegiate Baseball poll.
- After the UCSB series, Hawai'i will close the regular season on the road at Long Beach State. The three-game set is scheduled for Thursday, May 23 - Saturday, May 25 in Long Beach, Calif.

- Since head coach Mike Trapasso moved Dylan Thomas back to the bullpen in late March, Dylan Thomas has gone 21.0 innings over nine appearances, allowing just one run.
- Hawai'i pitchers are tied for third in the Big West with 7 runners picked off. Aaron Davenport has picked off three runners.
- UH catchers Tyler Murray is tied for fourth in the Big West in runners caught stealing with 10. Dallas Duarte is tied for seventh with six.
- UH pitchers are fourth in the Big West in ERA (4.49) and third in opponents batting average (.263).

HITTING NOTES

- On the season, Hawai'i has only been outscored by five of its 14 opponents.
- UH is 15-2 when scoring six or more runs this season. When scoring five or fewer runs, the 'Bows are 4-22.
- The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 61-37 in the eighth and ninth innings. The 'Bows have won six games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.
- Freshman Scotty Scott has hit in the leadoff spot in all 44 games this season. He's the only player to hit in the same spot in the lineup in every game this year. He's also the only player to start every game.
- Hawai'i ranks fourth in the Big West with a .277 batting average and third with an on-base percentage of .374.
- Two UH hitters rank in the top 27 nationally in toughest to strike out. Maaki Yamazaki (26th - 13 Ks / 165 AB), Dallas Duarte (27th - 11 Ks / 139 AB).
- As a team, Hawai'i has faced 14 different opponents for a series or single game in 2019. The Bows have hit .300 or better versus six of them.
- In four of the six series versus Big West opponents on the year, Hawai'i hit .305 or better as a team.

MAHALO TO OUR SENIORS

- ▶ UH will honor five seniors suiting up at Les Murakami for the final time.
- ▶ Colin Ashworth, Dominic DeMiero, Kash Kolterman, Ethan Lopez and Maaki Yamazaki have all exhausted their NCAA eligibility and will be recognized for their dedication to the program with a ceremony on Sunday.
- ▶ In his three seasons at UH, Ashworth has been one of UH's top relief pitchers since transferring from Orange Coast College. The native of Placentia, California has pitched in 29 games and has a career ERA of 3.86 with 28 strikeouts during his time with the 'Bows.
- ▶ Also in his third year with the program after transferring to UH from Bellevue College. The Washington native has been a consistent member of the pitching staff and is second among Hawai'i's active pitchers with seven career victories. This senior has made 29 career appearances with 25 starts. He has 78 strikeouts in his 137 career innings.
- ▶ Kash Koltermann is in second season with the Rainbow Warriors. Since transferring in from Bellevue College, he has pitched in 20 games with two starts. Over the course of his UH career, he has compiled 25 strikeouts in 50 innings on the mound. This season, he has contributed to victories over Iowa, Oregon, Longwood and Cal Baptist.
- ▶ Ethan Lopez is four year member of the team from Whittier, California. Among active UH players, he is the leader with 130 games played and 116 games started. He earned Second Team All-Big West in 2018 at third base. His career numbers include 12 home runs, 76 RBIs, 32 doubles. This season's highlight came in the form of a Grand slam in a win at UC Riverside.
- ▶ Maaki Yamazaki has been a mainstay at the shortstop position for the last two seasons. A First Team All-Big West honoree a year ago, he led the Rainbow Warriors with a .325 batting average. The Tokyo, Japan native is over the 300 mark yet again this season, hitting .309 all while playing stellar defense. He has appeared in 93 games with 92 starts while posting a .317 batting average and three home runs in two seasons with Hawai'i.
