## **MEWS AND NOTES**

- ▶ Hawai'i closes the 2019 season with a three-game road series at Long Beach State.
- ▶ UH has played just 15 road games this season entering the Long Beach State series. The Rainbow Warriors are 6-9 away from Les Murakami Stadium this season.
- ▶ The 'Bows are 8-17 in the all-time series versus Long Beach State. UH is 3-4 overall in games versus the Dirtbags in games played in Long Beach.
- Last season in the matchup in Honolulu, UH dropped the first two games of the LBSU series before earning a game-three victory by a 4-1 final score in a game highlighted by an Adam Fogel home run.
- ▶ Last time out, UH dropped three games to Big West-leading UCSB at Les Murakami Stadium in the final home series of the season.
- ▶ With 27 career saves, Dylan Thomas is currently tied for second in program history with Lenny Linsky. One more save would put him in a tie with Gene Smith for the most career saves in UH history (28). Among active D-1 pitchers, the redshirt junior is fourth in saves (27) and fourth in career ERA (1.99).
- ▶ Hawai'i has four starters hitting .295 or better led by Maaki Yamazaki's .312 average. Brennen Hancock is also above .300 entering the LBSU series, sitting at .307, while Scotty Scott (.298) and Daylen Calicdan (.295) are on the verge of the .300 mark.

#### **MAHALO TO OUR SENIORS**

- ▶ The Long Beach State series will mark the end of the collegiate careers for Colin Ashworth, Dominic DeMiero, Kash Kolterman, Ethan Lopez and Maaki Yamazaki as all five have exhausted their NCAA eligibility.
- ▶ They were honored with a Senior Day Ceremony on Sunday following the series finale vs. UCSB.
- ▶ In his three seasons at UH, Ashworth has been one of UH's top relief pitchers since transferring from Orange Coast College. The native of Placentia, California has pitched in 30 games and has a career ERA of 4.34 with 29 strikeouts during his time with the 'Bows.
- ▶ Also in his third year with the program after transferring to UH from Bellevue College. The Washington native has been a consistent member of the pitching staff and is second among Hawai'i's active pitchers with seven career victories. This senior has made 30 career appearances with 25 starts. He has 81 strikeouts in his 142 career innings.
- ▶ Kash Koltermann is in second season with the Rainbow Warriors. Since transferring in from Bellevue College, he has pitched in 21 games with two starts. Over the course of his UH career, he has compiled 28 strikeouts in 54.2 innings on the mound.
- ▶ Ethan Lopez is four year member of the team from Whittier, California. Among active UH players, he is the leader with 133 games played and 119 games started. He earned Second Team All-Big West in 2018 at third base. His career numbers include 13 home runs, 77 RBIs, 33 doubles. This season's highlight came in the form of a Grand slam in a win at UC Riverside.
- ▶ Maaki Yamazaki has been a mainstay at the shortstop position for the last two seasons. A First Team All-Big West honoree a year ago, he led the Rainbow Warriors with a .325 batting average. The Tokyo, Japan native is over the 300 mark yet again this season, hitting .312 all while playing stellar defense. He has appeared in 95 games with 93 starts while posting a .319 batting average and four home runs in two seasons with Hawai'i.
