# M NEWS AND NOTES

- Following the first road trip of the season, Hawai'i returns home to host UC Irvine for a three-game set to open Big West Conference play. The two sides will play single games March 29-31.
- Last time out, UH went 1-3 in a road series at Ohio State. After falling by a combined five runs in the opening three games of the series, the Rainbow Warriors exploded for a 15-3 win in the Sunday finale. The 15 runs are the most for UH in a game since a 15-8 victory at Pepperdine on Feb. 26, 2015, while the 19 hits are the most since a 20-hit game at UH Hilo on Feb. 14, 2016.
- In the Ohio State series, the Rainbow Warriors outscored the Buckeyes, 29-22, and had six starters hit .333 or better over the four games. Alex Baeza led the way with a .438 average (7-for-16) with four runs scored.
- Hawai'i is 11-28 in the all-time series versus UC Irvine.
- UH's first season competing in the Big West was 2013. The 'Bows have gone 9-9 in Big West opening series games and have won four of their six opening series since joining the league.
- The Rainbow Warriors lost their first nine games to UC Irvine upon entering the league. The 'Bows are 5-4 versus the Anteaters over the last three years, however, taking two out of three in last year's series in Irvine. UH won game one of last year's series versus UC Irvine, 4-3, and the final, 14-2, with a 12-4 loss in between the two wins.
- UC Irvine went 32-24 overall and 13-11 in the Big West in 2018. The Anteaters are ranked in the various national polls as high as No. 19 in the Baseball America Top 25 poll.
- After the UC Irvine series, the Rainbow Warriors will host UC Davis April 5-7 at Les Murakami Stadium.

#### **ABOUT THE UC IRVINE SERIES**

- UH is 11-28 in the all-time series versus UC Irvine.
- Since joining the Big West prior to the start of the 2013 season, Hawai'i is 5-13 versus UC Irvine.
- Over the last three seasons, Hawai'i is 5-4 against the Anteaters including 2-1 in last year's three-game set in Irvine.
- UH has won two of the last three series versus UC Irvine.

#### **FIRST SERIES IN BIG WEST PLAY**

- Hawai'i is in its seventh season in the Big West.
- The 'Bows have won four of their six opening series of Big West play and are 9-9 overall in opening series games.
- The 'Bows are opening Big West play versus UC Irvine for the fourth time.

#### PITCHING / DEFENSE NOTES

- Entering the series with CSU Bakersfield, UH pitchers averaged 4 walks per game. The number is now down to 3.5 per game.
- UH pitchers are tied for second in the Big West in batters struck out looking (50).
- The 'Bows have caught a league-best 13 runners stealing. Freshman catcher Dallas Duarte is tied for the league lead with sixth thrown out runners.
- Dylan Thomas is fourth in the Big West and 92nd nationally in strikeout to walk ratio (5.14). Li'i Pontes is fifth in the Best West and 97th nationally in strikeout to walk ratio (5.00).
- Freshman Aaron Davenport has not given up a run in his last two outings. He went a season-long 6.0 innings versus CSU Bakersfield, allowing one hit, no runs and no walks. He followed up 4.0 innings at Ohio State with two hits, two walks, no runs and a career-high eight strikeouts.

# **HITTING NOTES**

- The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 45-29 in the seventh and eighth innings. The 'Bows have won five games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.
- Hawai'i ranks third in the Big West with a .269 batting average.
- As a team, UH leads the Big West and is 52nd nationally with 117 walks.
- Three UH hitters rank in the top 91 nationally in toughest to strike out. Dallas Duarte (30th 5 Ks / 68 AB), Daylen Calicdan (70th 6 Ks / 68 AB), Maaki Yamazaki (91st 9 Ks / 94 AB).
- Daylen Calicdan is riding a four-game hitting streak and has hits in eight of his last nine games. Calicdan has two hits in each of his last three games, and raised his batting average from .255 before the Ohio State series to .294 after the series.
- Tyler Murray raised his average from .130 to .206 in the Ohio State series after going 4-for-11 with three runs scored in the series.
- Brennen Hancock has reached base in his last five games.
- Alex Baeza's batting average went from .319 to .341 after the OSU series. He went 7-for-16 (.438) including a three-hit game in the series finale. Baeza has at least one hit in 10 of his last 11 games.

#### **CLUTCH**

- Among UH's regulars, Daylen Calicdan and Alex Baeza are among the best on the team at hitting with runners on.
- Redshirt sophomore Alex Baeza delivered a 10th inning walk-off single in the series finale versus lowa in an 8-7 win (2/24/19).
- It was his second career walk off for UH.
- Baeza also hit a game-winning bases clearing double in a 7-6 win over Illinois State (3/16/18) in the 9th.
