M NEWS AND NOTES

- Hawai'i hosts UC Davis for a three-game set at Les Murakami Stadium April 5-7. The series is the second for UH in Big West play this season.
- The Rainbow Warriors are coming off a 1-2 weekend versus No. 19 UC Irvine to kick off Big West action. After winning the opener 10-2, UH fell by scores of 8-5 (Saturday) and 4-0 (Sunday).
- Junior Brennen Hancock led the Rainbow Warriors with a .444 average in the UC Irvine series. Starting all three games as the designated hitter, Hancock had an on-base percentage of .583 with four hits, one walk and two times getting hit by a pitch.
- For the season, redshirt sophomore Alex Baeza leads the 'Bows with a .327 batting average with freshman Scotty Scott ranking second on the team at .308.
- The Rainbow Warriors are 16-9 in the all-time series versus UC Davis.
- In last year's three-game set versus UC Davis on the road, UH won two out of three games. The 'Bows hit .348 for the series with Ethan Lopez hitting a home run. Dylan Thomas picked up saves in both of Hawai'i's wins versus UC Davis in 2018.
- In 2018, the Aggies went 18-35 overall and 9-15 in the Big West. This year, UC Davis is 9-12 (2-1 BWC), taking two of three games from UC Riverside in the Big West opening series.
- Following the series with the UC Davis Aggies, UH will have just six home games left on the 2019 schedule. The 'Bows will host Cal State Fullerton (April 18-20) and UC Santa Barbara (May 17-19).

- The 'Bows are second in the Big West and 63rd nationally in sacrifice bunts with 16.

- Redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas ranks third among active D1 pitchers with 24 career saves.
- The 2019 NCBWA Preseason Second Team All-American is also 10th among active D1 pitchers with a career ERA of 2.13 (MIN IP: 75.0; ERA: 0.10).

PITCHING / DEFENSE NOTES

- UH has utilized seven different starting pitchers this season.
- Out of the bullpen, three different pitchers have earned saves this season (Dylan Thomas, Calvin Turchin, Cade Smith).
- ullet UH pitchers are fourth in the Big West in both ERA (4.28) and opponents batting average (.258).
- Hawai'i's staff is second in the BW in batters struck out (212).
- The 'Bows are 85th nationally with a .972 fielding percentage, good for fourth in the Big West.

- UH, which went 1-3 at Ohio State and was 1-2 against UC Irvine, has scored more runs than its opponents in the last series. The Rainbow Warriors outscored Ohio State, 29-22, and UC Irvine, 15-14.

- The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 39-23 in the eighth and ninth innings. The 'Bows have won five games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.

- Scotty Scott has reached base safely in 13 games in a row. The freshman center fielder has 14 hits, six walks and three hit by pitches with a .269 batting average.
- Hawai'i ranks third in the Big West with a .264 batting average.
- Three UH hitters rank in the top 110 nationally in toughest to strike out. Dallas Duarte (14th 5 Ks / 77 AB), Daylen Calicdan (63rd 7 Ks / 79 AB), Maaki Yamazaki (110th 11 Ks / 104 AB).
