M NEWS AND NOTES

- The University of Hawai'i baseball team officially kicks off the 2019 season on Feb. 15 with a four-game series versus Portland out of the West Coast Conference. The series also includes a doubleheader on Feb. 16 and a single game to close the series on Feb. 17.
- The Rainbow Warriors open the 2019 campaign with 20-consecutive home games at Les Murakami Stadium. UH will play a total of 32 regular season home games this year.
- Hawai'i is the only school in the conference to bring back two First Team All-Big West performers from the 2018 selections. Senior shortstop Maaki Yamazaki returns after leading the 'Bows with a .325 batting average last season, while redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas had a 1.85 ERA last season and was named NCBWA Preseason Second Team All-America.
- Head Coach Mike Trapasso, now in his 18th season at UH, will have 18 returning letterwinners to work with in 2019. In addition to Yamazaki and Thomas, Trapasso will also have Second Team All-BWC third baseman Ethan Lopez and Honorable Mention All-BWC outfielder Adam Fogel back with another year of experience.
- UH, which was picked sixth in the Big West Preseason Poll, is coming off back-to-back winning seasons including a 27-24 record in 2018. Portland went 23-30 last season and is preseason No. 8 in the West Coast Conference poll in 2019.
- The Rainbow Warriors are 3-4 in the all-time series versus Portland.
- UH is looking for another strong start to the season after winning the first four games of the 2018 season.
- Following the series versus Portland, UH will host lowa for a four-game set Feb. 22-24.

INSIDE THE SERIES WITH PORTLAND

- Of the 10 teams that currently make up the West Coast Conference, Hawai'i is above .500 in the all-time series versus all of them except Portland. UH's record versus WCC teams is 171-104 entering the 2019 season.
- UH is 1-2 versus the Pilots in neutral site action.
- The last time the two sides met was March of 2011 when they split a four-game series at Hawai'i.
- This is the Pilots' first trip to Les Murakami Stadium since 2011.

SUMMER SUCCESS

- Three UH pitchers Dylan Thomas, Cade Smith and Jeremy Wu-Yelland made the all-star game of their respective summer leagues in 2018.
- Thomas made the All-Star game in the Cape Cod Baseball League and took home the Russ Ford Outstanding Relief Pitcher award.
- Smith made the all-star game in the California Collegiate League, and Wu-Yelland was honored in the West Coast League.

NEW ROLES

- After two years in the bullpen, First Team All-Big West pitcher Dylan Thomas is scheduled to begin the 2019 season as a starting pitcher. It will be Thomas' first time starting since his senior season in 2015 at Valencia High School in California.
- Thomas was named 2019 NCBWA Second Team Preseason All-American and to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List.
- "Coming from a redshirt year my freshman year, to not really know what I was going to do my sophomore year and trying to establish that closer role, then last year having that breakout year, I'm definitely excited to have worked my way into the starting rotation. That's a big deal. Most people would say the starting rotation is where you strive to be, and I'm definitely excited to be in the starting rotation." Dylan Thomas
- Junior Adam Fogel will make the move to center field to start the 2019 season.
- As a freshman in 2017, Fogel started 26 games in left field. As a sophomore in 2018, he made 40 starts in right field and eight in center field.

DISTANCE TRAVELED

- After playing the first 20 games at home on the season, the Rainbow Warriors will make the 4,503-mile journey to Columbus, Ohio to take on Ohio State.
- The remaining road games for UH in 2019 are in the state of California.
- Last season, UH traveled 4,138 miles (one way) to Baton Rouge, La. to take on LSU, and in 2017, the team made the 3,962-mile trek to Minneapolis, Minn.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME

- Hawai'i will play 32 home games at Les Murakami Stadium during the regular season.
- The 32 home games in 2019 are the second-most among Big West schools. Only UC Santa Barbara will play more home games this year (34).
- UH has played 30 or more home games in each of the last six seasons. The last time the 'Bows didn't play 30-plus home games was 2013 when they played 29.

- Jack Kennelly, Brennen Hancock and Calvin Turchin are new to the team in 2019.

THE BASICS

- UH's record at Les Murakami Stadium: 862-535-1 (.617)
- 36th season at the Stadium in 2019
- Debuted Feb. 17, 1984 for a game versus Stanford
- Capacity: 4,312
- Roof covers 3,738 seats from the "Manoa Mist"

FIRST SEASON

- Built 1984 on the site of the old UH Stadium
- Cost \$11.2 Million
- · Originally named Rainbow Stadium
- In the first year, the base paths, pitcher's mound and home plate consisted of a mixture of sand and crushed lava rocks

ADDITIONS, CHANGES AND RENOVATIONS

- Renovated in 1985 for \$12.2 million to add AstroTurf and Roof
- During the winter of 2007, the stadium's AstroTurf was replaced with Domo Turf surface
- Original seats were red, orange and blue before being replaced with all green seats in the fall of 2008
- Renamed Les Murakami Stadium in October of 2001

HOW IT HAPPENED

- Les Murakami pushed for the stadium to be built and with the financial backing from the state, took less than nine months to build.
- Murakami was the school's first Division I full-time head coach and the 11th coach in the program's history, dating back to 1923.
- Largely responsible for the stadium that is now compassionately known as "the house that Les built."

NOTES

- UH led the country in attendance twice, in 1986, averaging 2,599, and in 1992, averaging 4,433.
- The 208,378 fans that came through the gates in 1992 set an NCAA record that has since been eclipsed by Texas, and later Louisiana State.
- In 279 home dates during a six-year span from 1989-94, UH had a home record of 195-84 for a 69.9 winning percentage.
- Attendance flourished during that stretch, averaging 3,524 for a total attendance of 983,261, including 179 sellouts, nearly 65 percent of those games.
- The stadium was home to the minor league Hawai'i Islanders in 1986 and the Hawai'i Winter Baseball League on two separate stints.
- The Hawai'i Island Movers summer baseball club has used the facility for more than 20 years
