MEWS AND NOTES

• The University of Hawai'i baseball team hosts Iowa for the second four-game series of the season. UH and Iowa will play a single game on Friday, Feb. 22, a doubleheader on Saturday, Feb. 23 and a single game on Sunday, Feb. 24.

• The Rainbow Warriors opened the 2019 season last weekend by going 1-3 versus Portland.

• A pair of freshmen, Dallas Duarte and Scotty Scott, led UH in hitting in the opening weekend. Duarte went 6-for-13 (.462), while Scott finished 4-for-14 (.286).

• UH is 1-2 in the all-time series versus Iowa. The two sides split a pair of games in Honolulu during the 1983 season with Hawai'i winning 15-3 on March 20, 1983 before a 5-4 loss to the Hawkeyes on March 25, 1983. They met again in 2017 at U.S. Bank Stadium in Minneapolis, Minn. when Iowa earned a 7-6 win.

• The 'Bows are in the midst of a 20-game home stand to open the 2019 season. Hawai'i will play a total of 32 home games at Les Murakami Stadium this season.

• In the opening series, nine different players made their Hawai'i debuts. Six of them are freshmen and the other three are junior college transfers.

• Hawai'i is the only school in the conference to bring back two First Team All-Big West performers from the 2018 selections. Senior shortstop Maaki Yamazaki returns after leading the 'Bows with a .325 batting average last season, while redshirt junior pitcher Dylan Thomas had a 1.85 ERA last season and was named NCBWA Preseason Second Team All-America.

Head Coach Mike Trapasso, now in his 18th season at UH, has 18 returning letterwinners to work with in 2019.
 In addition to Yamazaki and Thomas, Trapasso will also have Second Team All-BWC third baseman Ethan Lopez and Honorable Mention All-BWC outfielder Adam Fogel back with another year of experience.

INSIDE THE SERIES WITH IOWA

- UH is 1-2 in the all-time series versus lowa.
- The two sides split a pair of games in Honolulu during the 1983 season. Hawai'i beat lowa, 15-3, on March 20, 1983 before a 5-4 loss to the Hawkeyes on March 25, 1983.
- They met again in 2017 at U.S. Bank Stadium in Minneapolis, Minn. Iowa earned a 7-6 win.
- Five players who played in the 2017 meeting for UH are on the current roster.

OPENING WEEKEND PITCHING NOTES

- Sophomore Cade Smith set a new career high with seven strikeouts on Feb. 16 versus Portland.
- Freshman Cade Halemanu earned his first career win in his first appearance going 1.1 innings of relief in UH's 9-5 win over Portland on Feb. 16.
- Graduate student Colin Ashworth pitched 2.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen versus Portland on Feb.
- 15. Dating back to last season, Ashworth has not given up an earned run in five of his last seven outings.

• In his first college outing, Li'i Pontes went five scoreless innings out of the UH bullpen vs. Portland (2/17/19). Of the six UH pitchers who threw three or more innings in the opening series, Pontes is the only one who did not give up a run.

• During the opening weekend, Hawai'i started four pitchers from the state of Washington - Jeremy Wu-Yelland (Spokane), Aaron Davenport (Duvall), Dominic DeMiero (Brier), Kash Koltermann (Lake Tapps).

OPENING WEEKEND HITTING NOTES

Junior Adam Fogel blasted a pair of home runs versus Portland on Feb. 16 for his first multi-home run game.
Redshirt sophomore Alex Baeza hit his first career home run on opening night vs. Portland. He followed up the next

day with a game-tying three-run homer in the bottom of the eighth in a Hawai'i victory.

• Freshman Dallas Duarte had a hit in all four games during opening weekend. He went 6-for-13 (.462) vs. Portland.

• Senior Maaki Yamazaki, who led UH with a .325 batting average last year, hit safely in all four games during opening weekend. Dating back to last season, Yamazaki has now reached base safely in 16 games in a row with hits in 15 of his last 16 games.

FOGEL'S POP

- Junior Adam Fogel is approaching Hawai'i career home record top 10 list.
- With 14 in his career (4 in 2017; 8 in 2018; 2 in 2019), Fogel is four away from tying with Todd Takayosh ('88-91) and Franz Yuen ('91-94) for 10th in school history with 18.
- The school record for career home runs in 30 by John Mathias ('85-89) followed by Kolten Wong ('09-11) in second with 25.

SUMMER SUCCESS

• Three UH pitchers - Dylan Thomas, Cade Smith and Jeremy Wu-Yelland - made the all-star game of their respective summer leagues in 2018.

- Thomas made the All-Star game in the Cape Cod Baseball League and took home the Russ Ford Outstanding Relief Pitcher award.
- Smith made the all-star game in the California Collegiate League, and Wu-Yelland in the West Coast League.

NEW ROLES

• Head coach Mike Trapasso announced that after two years in the bullpen, First Team All-Big West pitcher Dylan Thomas is scheduled to begin the 2019 season as a starting pitcher. The redshirt junior has not started in his UH career, and his last start was during his senior season in 2015 at Valencia High School in California.

 Thomas was named 2019 NCBWA Second Team Preseason All-American and to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Preseason Watch List.

- Junior Adam Fogel made the switch to center field to start the 2019 season.
- As a freshman in 2017, Fogel started 26 games in left field. As a sophomore in 2018, he made 40 starts in right field and eight in center field.

ADDITIONS, CHANGES AND RENOVATIONS

- Renovated in 1985 for \$12.2 million to add AstroTurf and Roof
- \bullet During the winter of 2007, the stadium's AstroTurf was replaced with Domo Turf surface
- Original seats were red, orange and blue before being replaced with all green seats in the fall of 2008
- Renamed Les Murakami Stadium in October of 2001

HOW IT HAPPENED

• Les Murakami pushed for the stadium to be built and with the financial backing from the state, took less than nine months to build.

• Murakami was the school's first Division I full-time head coach and the 11th coach in the program's history, dating back to 1923.

• Largely responsible for the stadium that is now compassionately known as "the house that Les built."

NOTES

• UH led the country in attendance twice, in 1986, averaging 2,599, and in 1992, averaging 4,433.

• The 208,378 fans that came through the gates in 1992 set an NCAA record that has since been eclipsed by Texas, and later Louisiana State.

• In 279 home dates during a six-year span from 1989-94, UH had a home record of 195-84 for a 69.9 winning percentage.

• Attendance flourished during that stretch, averaging 3,524 for a total attendance of 983,261, including 179 sellouts, nearly 65 percent of those games.

• The stadium was home to the minor league Hawai'i Islanders in 1986 and the Hawai'i Winter Baseball League on two separate stints.

• The Hawai'i Island Movers summer baseball club has used the facility for more than 20 years




