**H NEWS AND NOTES**

- The 'Bows are coming off a 1-3 series with Oregon last week. After a 7-6 win in the series opener on March 7, UH fell by a combined four runs over the next three games.
- Three of UH's regular starters are hitting .315 or better led by Maaki Yamazaki and his .333 average. Scotty Scott (.323) and Alex Baeza (.315) rank two and three on the team in batting average.
- UH is 0-1 in the all-time series versus Cal State Bakersfield, falling by a 4-3 final score on April 18, 2018 in Bakersfield. Maaki Yamazaki went 2-for-3 on the day, while Ethan Lopez knocked in a pair of runs.
- Cal State Bakersfield is 9-9 on the season, most recently completing a four-game sweep of Fairleigh Dickinson.
- It was announced on Nov. 27, 2017 that Cal State Bakersfield will be joining the Big West. The Roadrunners will become official members of the conference on July 1, 2020 and will be eligible to compete for all Big West championships and awards.
- Following the series with CSUB, UH will travel to Columbus, Ohio to take on Ohio State for a four-game set (March 21-24).

**ABOUT THE CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD SERIES**

- UH and CSUB squared off on April 18, 2018 at Hardt Field in Bakersfield.
- CSUB earned a 4-3 win after scoring all four runs in the first four innings.
- The game was played two days before the start of a three-game road series at Cal State Fullerton.
- The Roadrunners are making their first trip to Les Murakami Stadium.

**PITCHING / DEFENSE NOTES**

- Opponents are hitting just .193 off sophomore starter Jeremy Wu-Yelland. That number is second among UH pitchers who have gone more than 1.0 innings this season, trailing only redshirt junior Dylan Thomas (.152).
- UH's staff is allowing opposing batters to hit .251, that's fourth-best in the Big West.
- UH pitchers lead the league with 37 batters struck out looking.
- Hawaii catchers have thrown out a league-best eight runners on the year.
- In his last outing, Jeremy Wu-Yelland went a career-long 7.0 inning and did not allow an earned run versus Oregon.
- In UH's eight wins, the pitching staff has a 3.33 ERA. In the eight losses, the ERA is 5.55.
- Freshman Li'i Pontes has excelled out of the bullpen going 8.0 innings in two appearances versus Portland and Longwood with nine strikeouts without giving up a run. In his two start of the season versus Iowa and Oregon, Pontes went a total of 9.2 innings, giving up seven earned runs.
- Senior Dominic DeMiero has given up just three earned runs in his first three starts of the season. He went a season-long 4.1 innings in his March 10 start against Oregon.

**HITTING NOTES**

- Through 16 games, UH has been able to pick up late-game runs. The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 25-15 in the eighth and ninth innings.
- Hawaii ranks third in the Big West with a .272 batting average.
- Maaki Yamazaki is first in the Big West in hits (22) and ninth in batting average (.333).
- Alex Baeza leads the Big West in RBIs (18) and is seventh in slugging percentage (.574).
- Baeza hit safely in the final three games of the Oregon series, going 3-for-12 with two walks, five runs scored and three RBIs in the stretch.
- Daylen Calicdan went 5-for-15 (.333) against Oregon with two doubles, four runs scored and four runs batted in.
- Scotty Scott has six multi-hit games this season. He posted a season-best four hits in UH's win over Oregon on March 7.
- Scotty Scott stole three bases versus Longwood on March 2. It is the most for a UH player in a game since the 2015 season.
- Maaki Yamazaki continues to hit well. After entering the Longwood series with a .206 average, the senior went 10-for-17 (.588) versus Longwood and followed up by going 5-for-15 (.333) against Oregon. On his current nine-game hitting streak, Yamazaki is 17-for-35 (.486).
