M NEWS AND NOTES

- Hawai'i hits the road for the first time this season for a four-game series at Ohio State with single games March 21-24.
- The Rainbow Warriors recently completed a 20-game homestand to open the 2019 season. UH came out of the stretch with a 9-11 record going 1-3 versus Portland, 2-2 versus lowa, 4-0 versus Longwood, 1-3 versus Oregon and 1-3 versus CSU Bakersfield.
- UH went 9-11 on the road last season.
- Freshman outfielder Scotty Scott, who has started all 20 games this season, leads the team with a .325 batting average. In the Rainbow Warriors' four-game set versus CSU Bakersfield, Scott went 5-for-15 (.333).
- Ohio State, which is 10-10 on the season, went 36-24 a year ago and qualified for the NCAA Tournament, competing in the Greenville Regional.
- The UH history book lists a 1956 matchup between Hawai'i and Ohio State when UH fielded a club team. The game is listed as a 4-3 loss for the Rainbow Warriors.
- After the series at Ohio State, the 'Bows return to Hawai'i to take on UC Irvine for the start of Big West play.

ABOUT THE OHIO STATE SERIES

- UH is facing its second Big Ten opponent this season after going 2-2 versus lowa earlier this season.
- A matchup between UH and Ohio State is listed in the UH history book from the 1956 season when UH fielded a club team. The game is listed as 4-3 win for Ohio State.

PITCHING / DEFENSE NOTES

- There were two games in the four-game set versus CSU Bakersfield where UH pitchers did not issue a walk. Entering the series with the Roadrunners, UH pitchers had averaged 4 walks per game, but the number is down to 3.65 per game.
- UH pitchers allowed CSU Bakersfield to hit just .238 in the series. It was the second lowest for the staff in a series this season (.195 vs. Longwood).
- UH pitchers lead the Big West in batters struck out looking (43).
- The 'Bows have caught a league-best nine runners stealing. Freshman catcher Dallas Duarte has thrown out five runners.
- Dylan Thomas is allowing batters to hit just .171 off him. As a team, UH pitchers are allowing a .249 batting average.
- In his last outing, freshman Aaron Davenport went a season-long 6.0 innings versus CSU Bakersfield, allowing one hit, no runs and no walks.
- In UH's nine wins, the pitching staff has a 3.18 ERA. In the 11 losses, the ERA is 5.04.

HITTING NOTES

- Through 20 games, UH has been able to pick up late-game runs. The 'Bows are outscoring their opponents 33-20 in the eighth and ninth innings. The 'Bows have won five games when this season when trailing after the seventh inning.
- Hawai'i ranks fourth in the Big West with a .257 batting average.
- As a team, UH leads the Big West with 100 walks.
- Three UH hitters rank in the top 50 nationally in toughest to strike out. Dallas Duarte (39th 4 Ks / 53 AB), Maaki Yamazaki (40th 6 Ks / 79 AB), Daylen Calicdan (46th 4 Ks / 51 AB).
- Freshman Scotty Scott continues to impress at the plate. He leads the 'Bows with a .325 batting average. His average has not dipped below .273 all season. Scott has a team-best eight multi-hit games on the year.
- Redshirt sophomore Alex Baeza has reached base safely in 17 of his 19 games played this season. The lefty first baseman leads UH with four home runs and a .565 slugging percentage.
- Maaki Yamazaki entered the Longwood series with a .206 average. Since then, the senior shortstop has raised his aveage 98 points highlighted by going 10-for-17 (.588) versus Longwood and 5-for-15 (.333) against Oregon. Yamazaki has a hit in 16 of UH's 20 games this season.

CLUTCH

- Redshirt sophomore Alex Baeza delivered a 10th inning walk-off single in the series finale versus lowa in an 8-7 win (2/24/19).
- It was his second career walk off for UH.
- Baeza also hit a game-winning bases clearing double in a 7-6 win over Illinois State (3/16/18) in the 9th.
- Fellow redshirt sophomore Daylen Calicdan had a bases-clearing double in the eighth to knock in the go-ahead runs in a win over Oregon (3/7/19).
- Calicdan followed up a week later with a go-ahead double to score two runs in a comeback win over CSU Bakersfield (3/14/19).
