Post-Game Quotes

Chuck Stobart, Utah - "It's a shame. It's a shame that a football game played like that has to be decided by a call like that, instead of the players playing. That's the sad thing about it.

"I don't want to take anything away from Hawaii. They played well and we played well. They had no turnovers and our defense worked well."

(Stobart was talking about two calls--the roughing kicker that wasn't called and the personal foul called on setting up the field goal.)

Dick Toney, Hawaii - "That was a good win. That was the first time we played this year. We played like we can. It was a hard win. That's the way we played for years. We took a great step in the right direction; to win the game on the last plays of the game, it was just a real good tough football game."

(On why Spelman was used over Larsen): "We had a kick-off. Richard (Spelman) made 9 of 10 and Lee (Larsen) made 7. It's just that simple." (Kick off was done Thursday at practice)

"That a great clutch kick by Richard Spelman. He earned a scholarship and I gave him the game ball."

Richard Spelman, Hawaii - "It didn't bother me (the time out that Utah called). Everybody was behind me and I just relaxed. That drive was the best thing that happened in the whole game. All I had to do was kick it."
