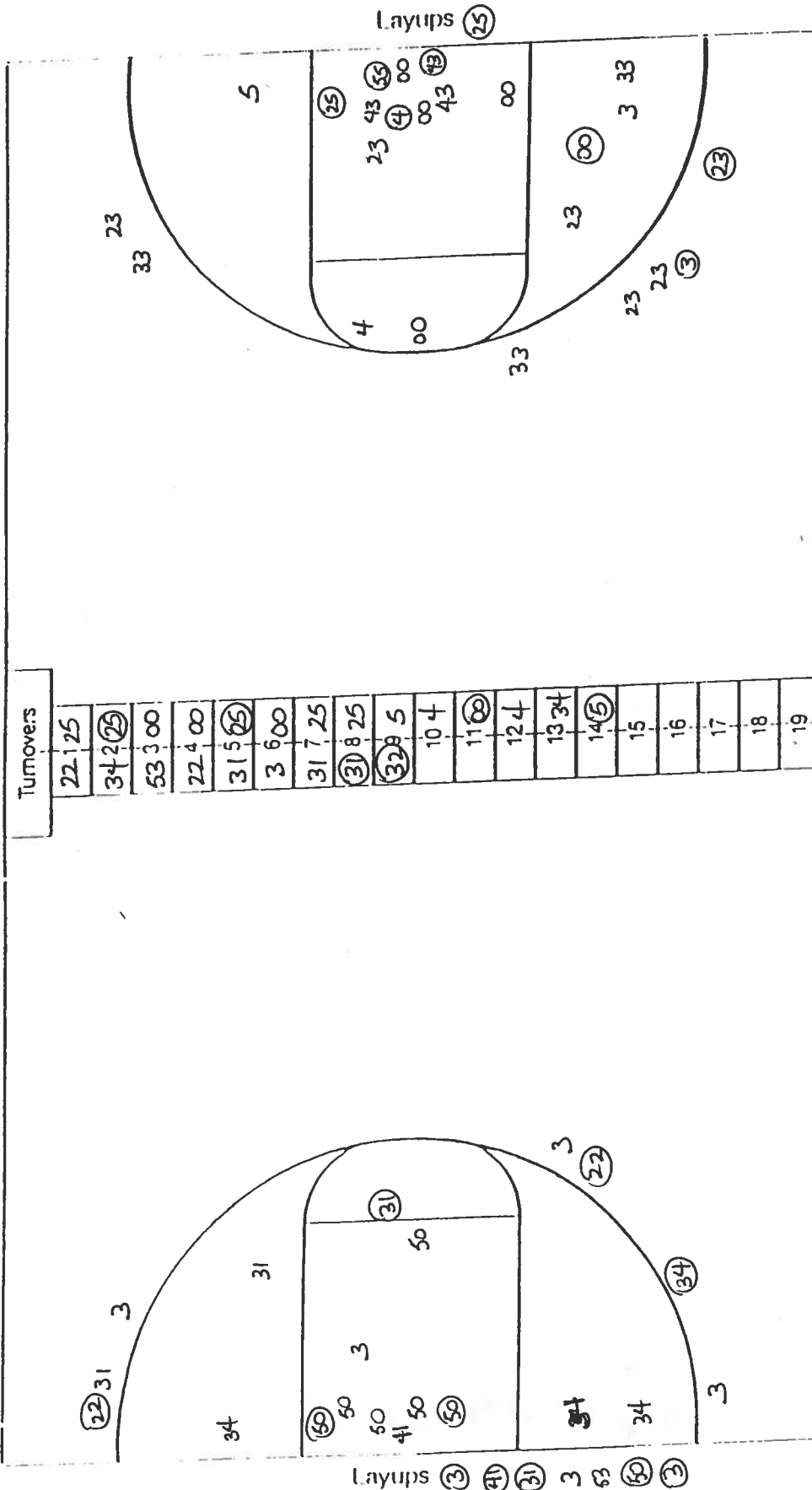

POST-GAME QUOTES

Hawai'i Coach Riley Wallace:

"I thought it would be a game of who could motivate and get started after tough losses. We've been in this situation in this tournament a couple years before when we lost to Washington State and had to play Villanova who was down after their loss and our guys got fired up. It helped that Cincinnati was nationally ranked at 20 because we wanted to come out of this tournament with victories over nationally ranked teams. Just get out there, get after it, and get some recognition and get your team believing in themselves. We weren't happy about losing to a good Iowa team but we bounced back and the guys mixed things up well. We got some good buckets early on when we could them a little flat and then we put our defense on them really well. Our man was working and then we switched to a zone and got them standing around a little bit. It allowed Tony (Maroney) to roam around the middle a bit more. I thought he intimidated their inside game. I thought our defense looked very very solid."

Hawai'i guard Tes Whitlock:

"We knew this was going to be our last chance at national exposure before going into the WAC so we didn't want to let this one slip. We knew it was going to be tough but we didn't want to let it slip, let N.C. (North Carolina) go, let Iowa go. We had to get them (Cincinnati). We just came out and concentrated and we got them."

Hawai'i forward Phil Handy:

"I felt bad that we let North Carolina get away and it really hurt to let Iowa get away with a two-point game. I believe that we're a good enough team that we should be in the top 25. But we got to work for it and I think we proved somethings by beating Cincinnati today."

Cincinnati Coach Bob Huggins:

"It's tough to win without all your guys (referring to foul trouble). We were just missing shots and throwing the ball away. We had to try to generate offense with our defense. We had to play guys that could pressure and try to get us back in the game. We were back in the game, we were down to five when Marko (Wright) throws it to Chuck (radio announcer) over in the broadcast booth. We cut it to three when Zelle (Durden) shoots one from half court. But our kids battled. It's not as if our kids didn't compete. I mean, they're (Hawai'i) a good team. I can't take anything away from them. They're a good basketball team and Riley (Wallace) is a good coach."
