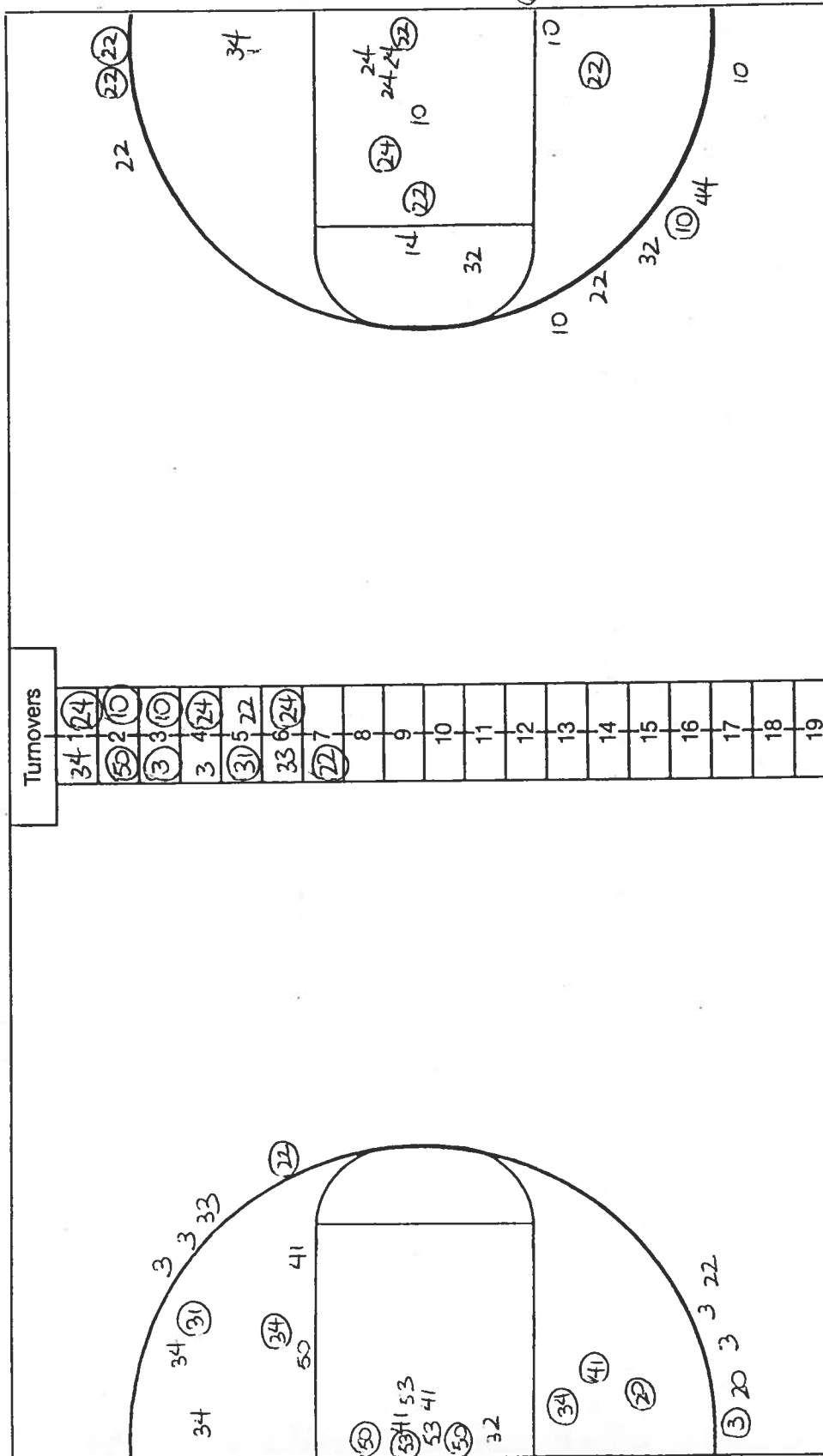

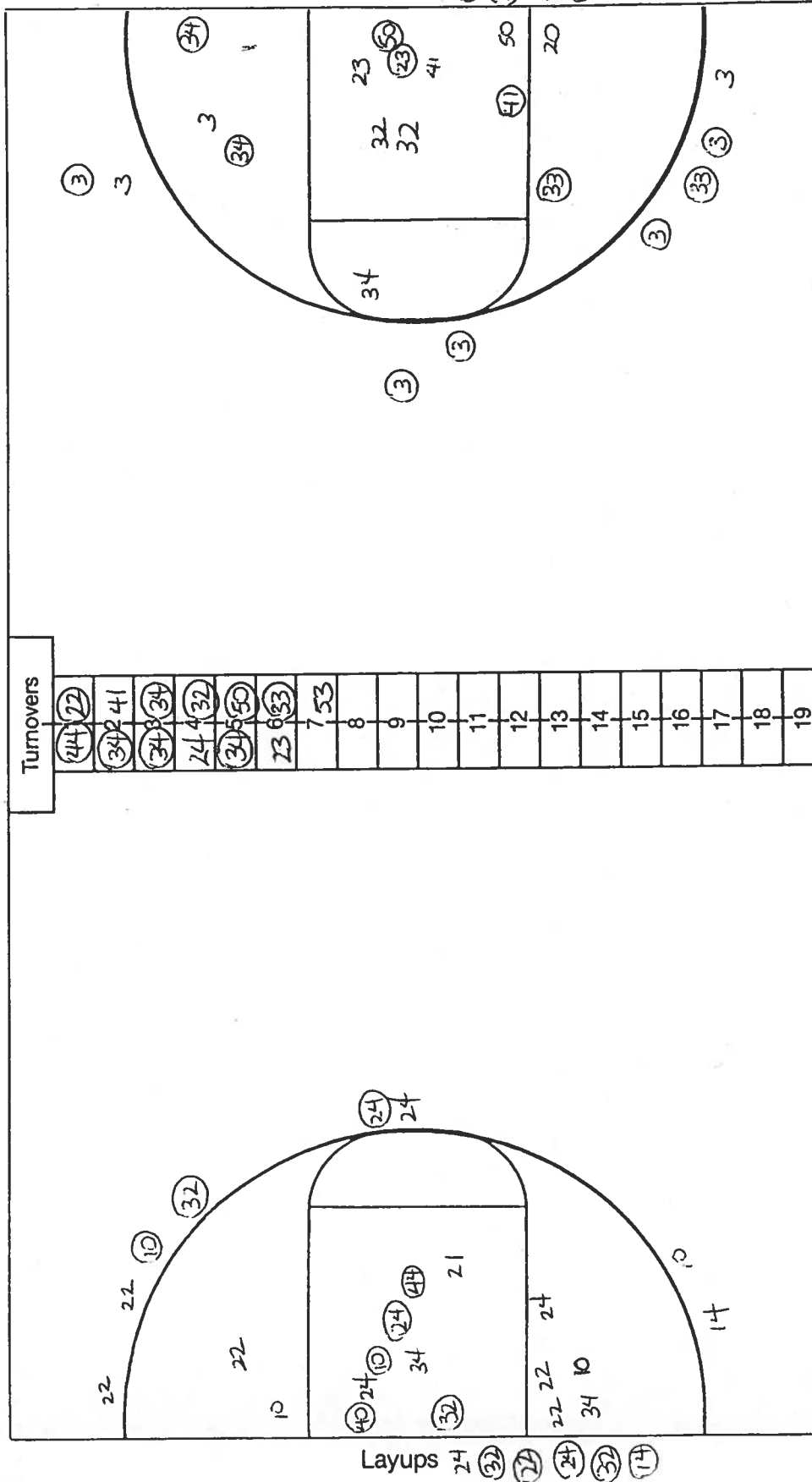

POST-GAME QUOTES

Hawai'i Coach Riley Wallace:

"I know we have more talent than Air Force does, but they stay together, they work hard. They're well coached but they're a little short-handed because of requirements to get into the academy. But they play so well together, they're so disciplined and do a lot of right things. They'll find the guys that shoot the ball. If we can get into a ballgame and our guys keep their concentration and play hard defensively, offensively things will happen. We usually come up with a good game plan against these guys. We don't usually switch on a lot of guys because they have mismatches, but because of their sizes, we could switch any position. We switched the cross-picks down low with (Justice) Sueing and (Tony) Maroney because they didn't have a big guy.

"I told our guys it makes sense to take advantage, travel's got to hurt them some so we had to try run on them a little more and wear them down and try to break them down late in the ballgame. "

Air Force Coach Reggie Minton:

"Obviously we shot very poorly. For us, we don't shoot well, it causes a terrific problem for us. I thought we played well, I thought we did some things well. I didn't like the way the game started off when they had two or three dunks. They got some things easy on transition and that put us in a hole. But we fought back to give us a fighting chance. When we get guys healthier, we'll be able to play with the best of them.

"I think Hawai'i's a good team. The problem with this league is the travel."
