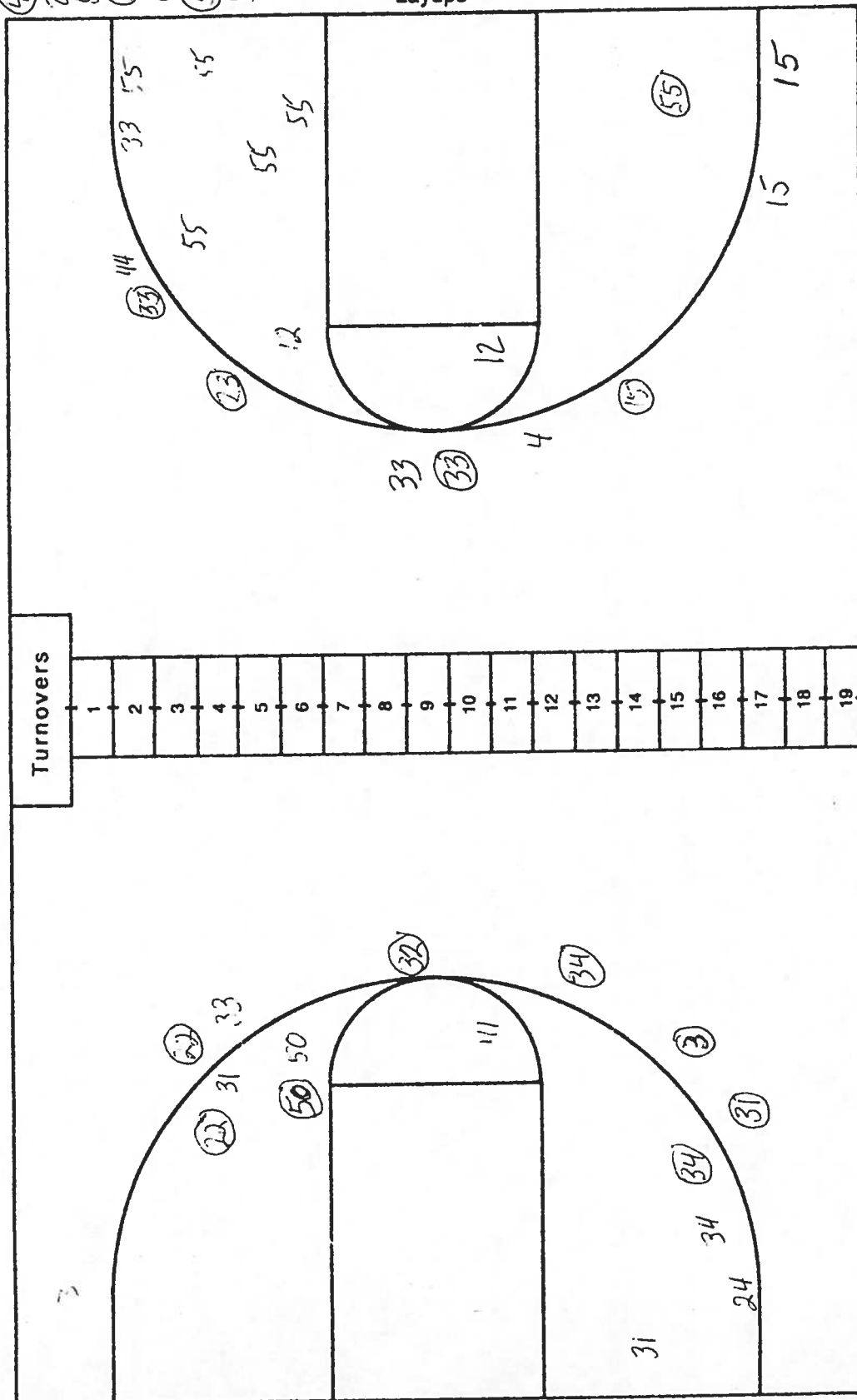

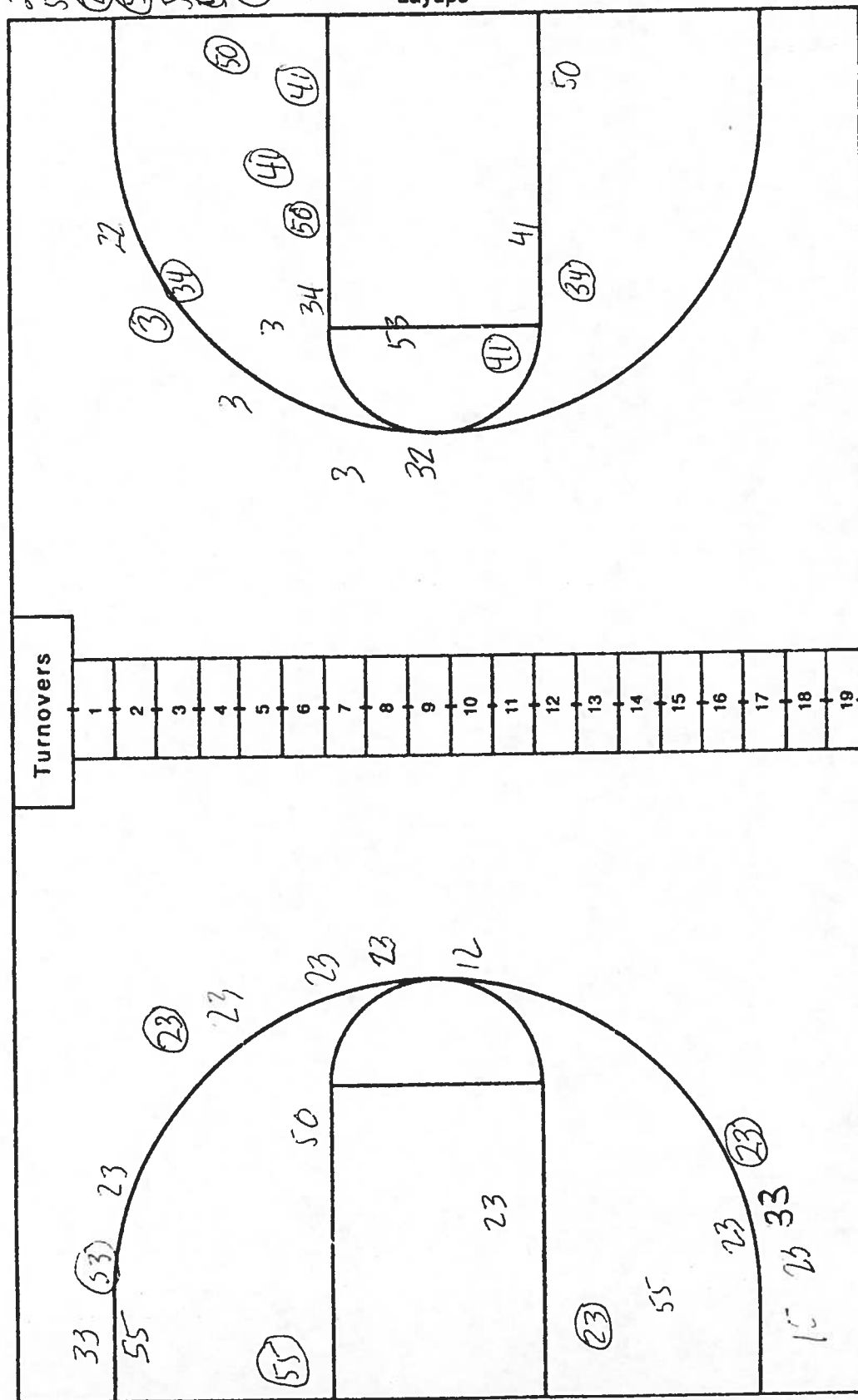

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QUOTES FOR (7) HAWAII AND (6) COLORADO STATE MEN'S GAME:
(FRI. 3/10/95)

COLORADO STATE HEAD COACH STEW MORRILL:

"We just had a helluva time against their zone. In the first half, we just were very passive and non-aggressive. Obviously the 10-point cushion helped them. We battled back in the second half and attacked it a bit more aggressively. They did all we could ask. We kept battling but just could never get over the hump. The last shot wasn't exactly what we diagrammed up, but we couldn't have asked for a better look. We could have run our best play, and Joe's 50 percent from there in league. He doesn't take a lot of 'em, but (he's) a very good shooter facing the basket. There wasn't a lot of time left, and he gets a wide open look -- it goes down and pops back out. Their zone was very effective, and I thought it was the difference in the ballgame."

CSU CENTER JOE VOGEL:

(On the last shot to tie) "I was supposed to go down and set the screen for Delmonte (Madison). And for some reason he didn't get open. So Bobby (Sellers) just drove the basketball, and when Maroney picked up on him I just stepped back. I got a good look -- I can't complain about that shot, and I don't think Coach would either. I was just hoping it would go down, but at that point it just didn't. That's just the way it goes. "

HAWAII HEAD COACH RILEY WALLACE:

"I thought we came out of the chutes just playing pretty good again. We knocked down the shots we needed and worked at building up the lead. And our substitutions worked again for us. I thought the platoon coming in kind of wore them down a bit. In the second half it was a repeat of last night. They came out of the chutes and scored about eight points before we answered. We just kept working and stayed as patient as you'll ever see us these two nights in our offense. The key was, when we switched from the man to the 1-2-2 zone, we got a gap at the top, and if you watch the BYU game they did a lot of slashing. And if you don't cover it, they kick it back for the three. The zone kept their wing man standing a lot, and they couldn't get the ball inside a lot. We really shot the ball well in the first half. We knew they were saying 'they'll cool off in the second half,' so we knew we just have to stay with it."

HAWAII CENTER TONY MARONEY:

(On who he'd rather play) "Utah always sends a double team straight at me and makes it very hard. It makes it hard for me to make a move and kick the ball out."
