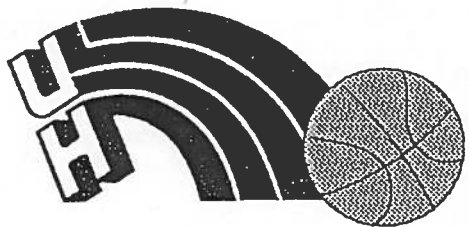

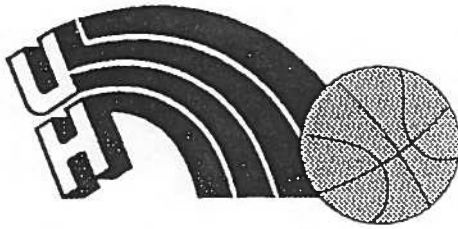

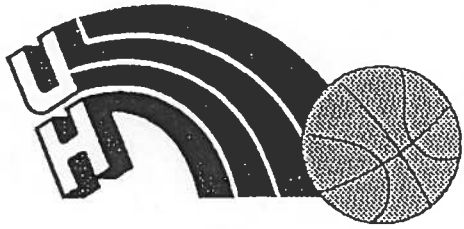

Post-game Quotes

University of Hawaii Head Coach Riley Wallace: "Well, we've been working hard on defense all week. We knew Whitehead is the guy that ignites their offense and makes them go. We did a good job on him. We did a good job on their penetrators and three-point shooters. But we came out and our offense was struggling. I told Alike (Smith) and (Justice) Sueing that they had to get in there and work with Anthony (Harris). In the second half they came out and played much better. Sammy (Smith) came in off the bench and contributed."

"We had no offense in the first half. We just had to keep going after it. We knew that their defense would break down eventually and there would eventually be a seam. And it opened up after a while."

"In the past we did not have to worry about bench power. Now we have to just keep searching till we find something. Sam came in tonight and gave us good minutes. He's young s9 he has a lot of energy. Tonight he played with both control and energy."

"It's the same old thing. Anybody can beat anybody in the WAC. As long as you keep winning at home and you can steal one or two on the road when you not supposed to, you have a good chance of doing well in the WAC."

Ales Zivonavic Hawaii Forward: "We were shooting 25 percent in the first half and that's real bad. But we were playing good defense so it kept us in the game. We just stayed together and started playing like we should in the second half. In basketball, everything is forward not back. You just have to keep shooting and making rebounds and keep playing, then everything will be all right."

Sam Smith Hawaii Guard: "We were struggling from the start. But we knew what we had to do. After the experience we had at the Rainbow Classic, we definitely knew what it felt like to loose, and we did want that. We wanted to get the WAC season off to a good start. The Classic prepared us for that. After playing two top 20 teams and playing a team like Illinois so close, we knew we were ready. We just had to go out and do what we knew we had to."

Joby Wright Wyoming Head Coach: "It came down to the fact that we just couldn't put the ball in the hole, especially in the second half. Outside of Coleman and Roberts, we couldn't get anything done. LaDrell, Aaron and Sly were not shooting the ball well."

"We knew a key would be to stop their penetration, and we didn't do a very good job of that in the second half. They shot 80 percent in the second half and a lot of those were layups."

"I thought we played pretty well for 30 minutes, but unfortunately it's a 40-minute game. We had that stretch in the middle of the second half that really hurt us. They got a run going and that was the difference in the game."
