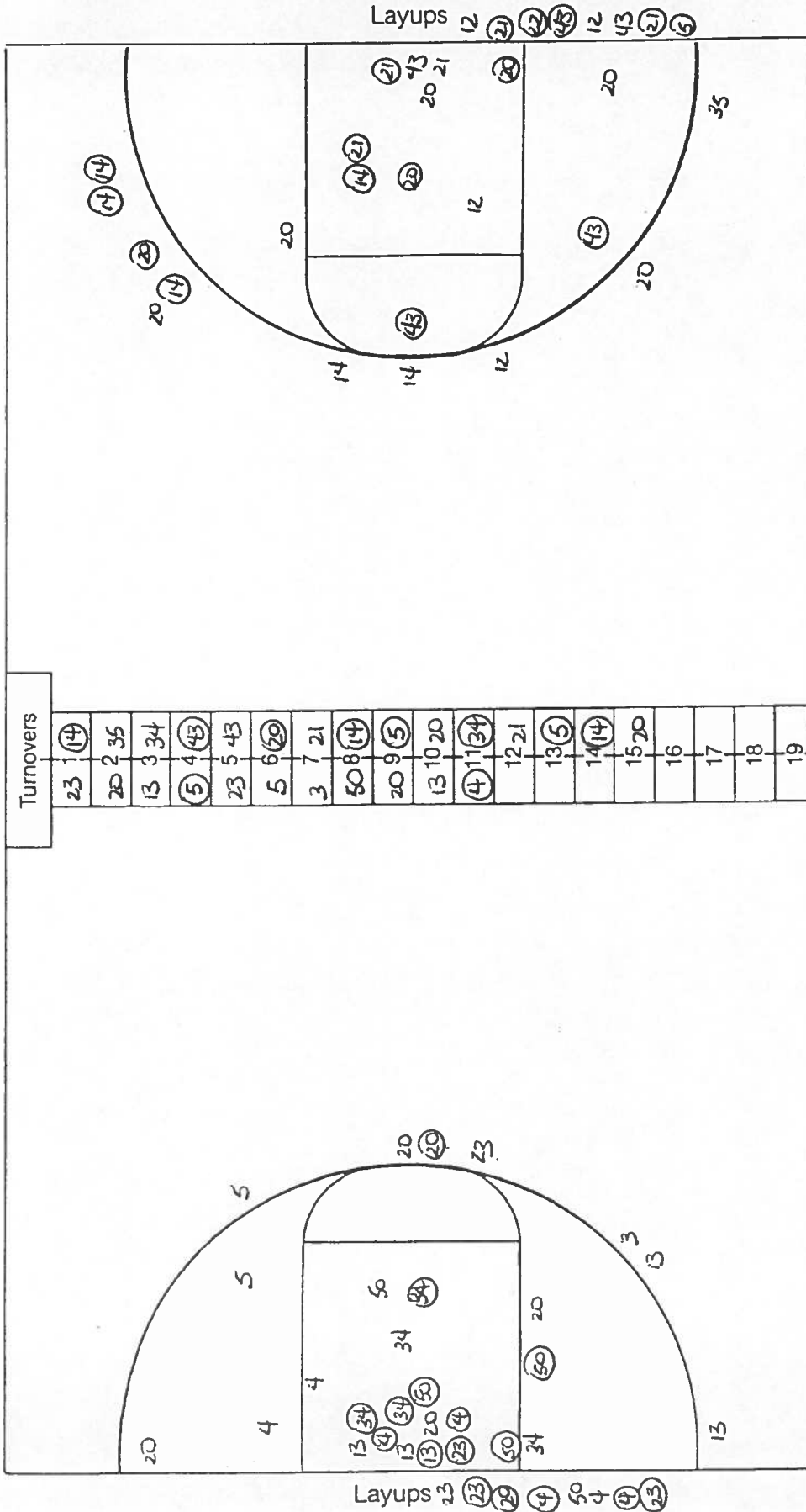

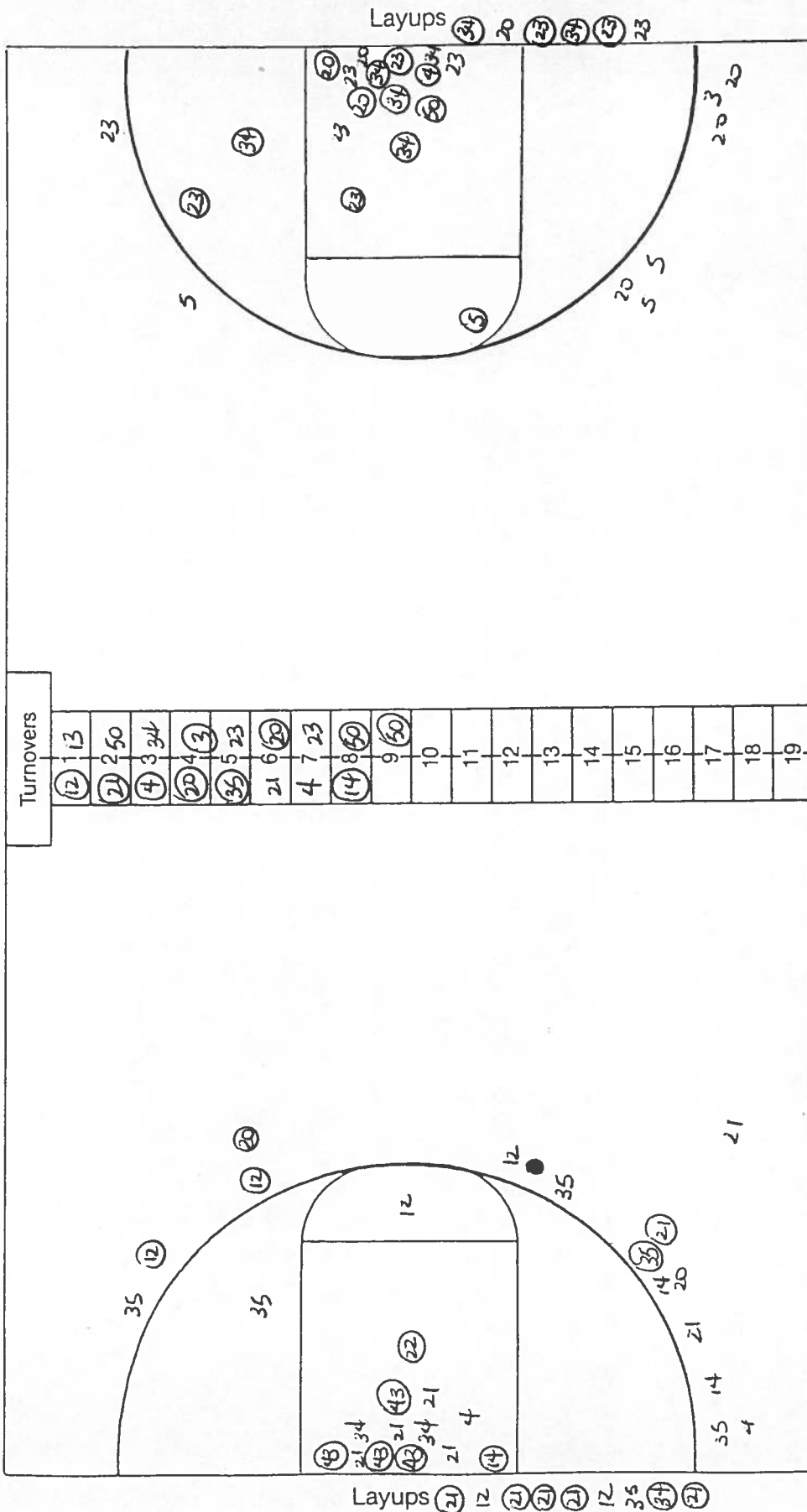

Post Game Quotes

Cal Poly Head Coach Jeff Schneider: "Obviously that's a tough way to lose a basketball game, winning with just seconds left. It was a tough game. Our guys were 305 in the country two years ago. I was real proud of our guys effort and that's obviously a tough way to lose a basketball game."

"We got in foul trouble. It's tough when you have the ball and you're taking a shot to win. It wasn't exactly a tap in offensive rebound. I think everybody in this arena knew that it was going to be a tough way for us to win."

"I think the WAC is a bigger, stronger league, a more physical league, so going in I knew it was going to be a physical game. I'm proud of the way our players stepped up and fought and we had a chance to win the game. But Hawai'i made some big shots. They made a big comeback when we were up seven and they showed a lot of poise by making those plays and they had a nice bounce on the last shot. You hate to lose on a last second play like that."

Hawai'i guard Alike Smith: "It was a rough game. I don't know if we came in overconfident or what, but we didn't handle their press or their zone very well and we're going to see that a lot more, so we're going to have to work on it and hopefully we'll do better tomorrow."

"It was a hard fought game tonight. They played real well, can't take that away from them, but we didn't play up to our ability and it showed out there. We were a lot bigger and a lot stronger, but I don't know if we really used that to our advantage."

Hawai'i Forward Eric Ambrozich (on the game winning free-throws): "I just stepped up to the line, tried to stay confident, tried not to think about it too much. I just wanted to make sure that I made the first one cause that was the one with all the pressure on it."

Hawai'i Head Coach Riley Wallace: "(Cal Poly) played some good defense and they came back and made some shots, got some easy layups off of it. We got up by eight and tuned right around, turned over the ball and gave up a three where we didn't get out on them and the next thing you know, their right back in the ball game. You gotta respect their style, cause they really get up and down the floor and they play really really hard. They probably deserved to win tonight, we were lucky. We got a call tonight, you know, we're at home, but you gotta make those free-throws you know and Eric (Ambrozich) was "iceman" tonight. He stepped up and hit both of 'em. We'll take them any way we can get them."

"Bad thing is we lose Seth (Sundberg) on a retaliation call. The guy hit him first and he retaliated. That's the new rule, we lost him and we lost the ball on the possession arrow, so it was a very important turnover there and we lose him for tomorrow night so that will really hurt us."
