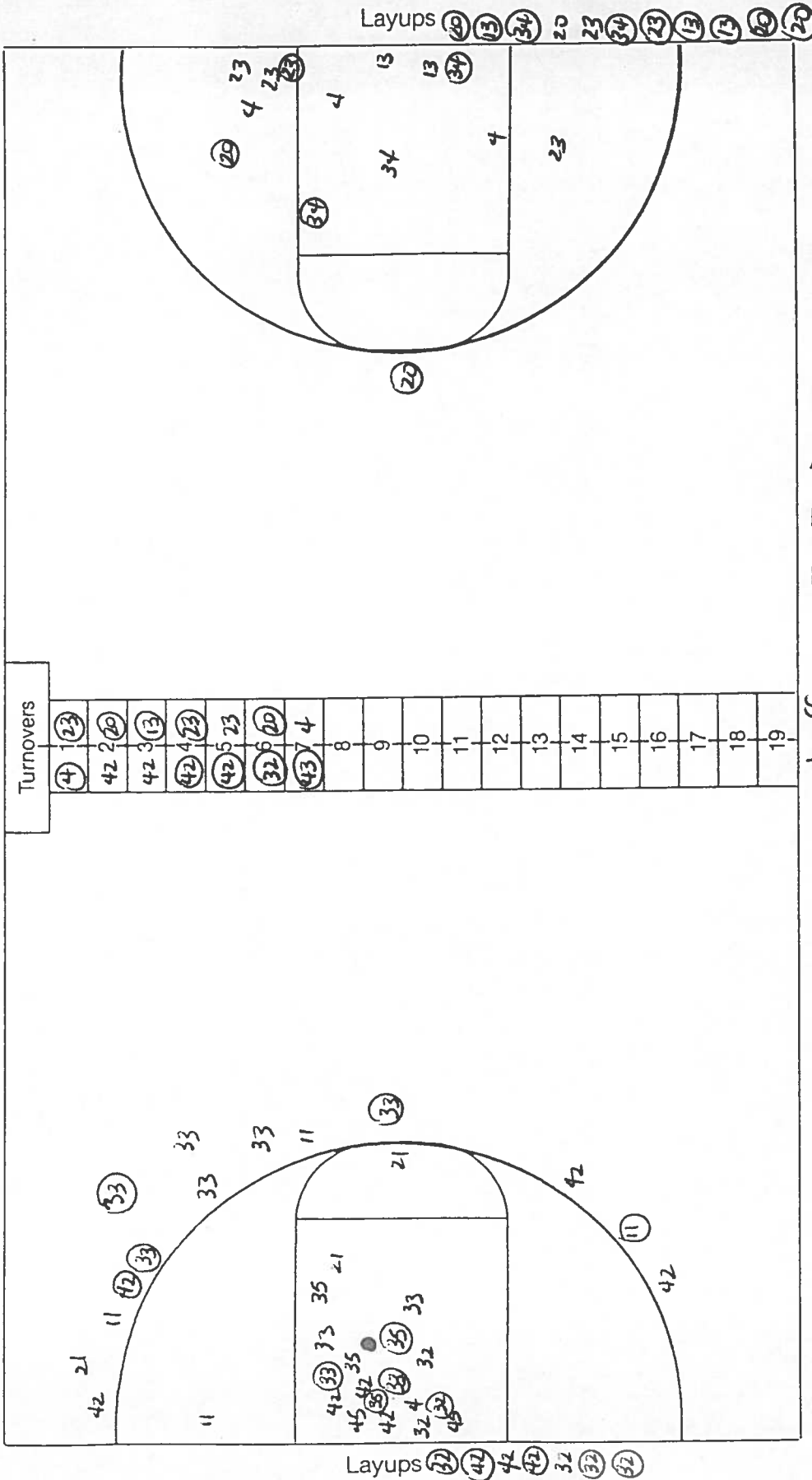

QUOTES

MICHAEL ROBINSON HAWAI'I FORWARD (ON FIRST START OF THE YEAR):  
"Starting is no big deal for me. Whether I start or come off the bench, I still have to play hard and give 110 percent. Our center wasn't there today, but I tried to step it up and of course the whole team did too."

Alika Smith Hawai'i Guard: (On the zone defense UH played)"I think we caught them off guard. They didn't expect it because none of our films showed zone. So I think it disturbed them a bit and I think that that's what kept us in the game."

Head Coach Ray McCallum Ball St.: "We hadn't seen them in much zone at all. I thought their zone was effective. It slowed us down, got us out of the rythm and they were able to get some long rebounds out of it and get out in transition and have some success."

"We wanted to have balance. We wanted to get the ball inside, and we were able to do that late. they just slowed us down. The big thing for us was defensively. We just didn't defend the way we've been defending and they were able to get some transistion baskets. And that Robinson kid played a great ball game."

Head Coach Riley Wallace: "Everybody here was more concerned than I was about tonight and not haveing Seth Sundberg. Because there was about a week there in preseason where Seth and Danny (Furlong) didn't really do anything in practice and I saw this linup as being a possibility. We looked quicker and was able to do some things. And when we press, that is the lineup we are going to have in there. So it wasn't that I wasn't confident about these guys, my only concern was with Mike. I wasn't sure if he was ready to play 40 minutes of basketball, because we run a lot of different offenses when our opponent is playing man and he doesn't really know how to get in them yet. So I've tried to ease him in and out and he's learning in practice and we just do repetition in practice without a defense to make them think about it. And he did mess up a few times tonight but he made up for it on the boards."

"The key tonight was the zone defense. Their coaching staff could not have anticipated that at all, because that was the first time that I know of, in 10 years that I have played 40 minutes of zone. Tonight that was the difference. Bonzi (Wells) presented us a problem, because of the matchup of Kroeger and him. You're always going to have to help and it weakens your defense if you're always in that situation. So I felt we'd go with the zone for as long as we could and if it worked we'd stay with it and if it didn't, we'd go after them the way we like to in man."
